



# Bikeability Level 3 Advanced Cycle Training Holiday Courses (Maidstone)

## Who is it for?

This course is ideal for children who have already achieved level 2 Bikeability at primary school and are looking for that extra confidence on the bicycle before starting secondary school.

## What is it?

Courses run over 2 days for 2 hours each day. The training is delivered in pairs (each instructor works exclusively with 2 children so everybody gets lots of focused attention).

Training begins with a revision of level 2 Bikeability skills and continues to take in more advanced traffic situations. We focus on helping the children plan and ride a safe route (typically to school or other favourite destination). The route will include traffic lights, roundabouts and utilise established cycle routes where possible. Children will learn to anticipate other road users' behaviour and carry out manoeuvres with skill and confidence.

At the end of the course successful children get a **Level 3 Bikeability** certificate/badge and we provide feedback to parents on the child's progress.
